- 1(per scout) Class A Shirt

- At least 1 Liter of Water per scout**
- One Gallon of Water in each sled**
- 1 metal garbage can lid
- 3 Bricks (to keep lid off ground)
- 1(per scout) Can of Soup Turn in at Hard Times
- 1 Compass
- 1 12-inch ruler
- 1 pen and/or pencil and paper

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Boy Scout Lunchiak (Cook Town) Supply List and Requirements:

Note: All cooking will be on Propane stoves that each patrol brings along with them on the Klondike sled. Backpacking stoves can also be used for heating water and / or cooking. NO Charcoal can be used at Sandy Hook!

Leaders: Please ensure the patrols READ below at least two weeks prior to the Klondike Derby. The patrols have 4 things to show the judges:

1. A Menu
2. Shopping list: (items to buy and quantity)
3. Cook Town Gear list
4. Receipt from **their** shopping adventure. (the boys shopping adventure!)

Prepare a written Patrol lunch Menu and shopping list. Bring the menu and shopping list in a Ziplocs bag Readable Please. (scored)	Prepare a Patrol Cook Town Equipment list to prepare your meal and keep your guys warm with Hot soup and Coco. Bring the list in a zip lock bag. (scored)	Bring Receipt in zip lock for the items you bought. Explain where you got all ingredients.
Plan 1 Hot lunch stew/or dish that is NO hamburgers or hot dogs or any thing similar	Hot soup for all. (quality and heathiest will be scored.)	Bring a yummy Dessert that was baked at home. Show the judge before you start eating it and ensure in your travels it looks the same at Cook Town as it did out of the oven. Photo of scouts baking it is Bonus point
At least 1 Hot cocoa packet per scout. More is ok.	Proper Storage of food will be scored	Kitchen set up will be scored. Including safe set up of stoves
Team work will be scored: more scouts helping the better.	Cleaning will be scored: Back pack cleaning methods	Ways shown scouts minimized clean-up will be scored.
Fork and plate for the Judge	At least 1 small propane burner and/or back-packing size stove	1 Tarp at least 8' x 10' (could be bigger)
2 large garbage bags: Scout mess kit/ knife/fork/spoon/ hot cup per scout 1 hour will be provided for cook Town
